- Influenza (the flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by a virus.
- The flu can cause fever, sore throat, cough, headache, fatigue, chills and muscle aches.
- Anyone wanting protection from influenza should get a flu shot yearly.
- October or November is the best time to get vaccinated. Getting a flu shot in December or later will still protect you.

## COSTS

Influenza=\$15

Pneumococcal=\$40

Tetanus=\$20

Shots for children under two are free.  
Medicare and Medicaid are accepted.
