

## CHAPTER 2

### ADMINISTRATION DIVISIONS OF THE CORPORATION

#### Article 1. Structural Organization.

Sec. 2-101 Divisions. There shall be two Divisions of the Corporation, as provided by law. These shall be the Division of Public Health and the Division of Public Hospitals. These two divisions shall administer the delivery of services to the public; the Division of Public Health having the responsibilities for control and prevention of disease and the functions of the local board of health and the Division of Public Hospitals having the responsibility for treatment and curative functions through hospital or health facilities. *[Gen.Ord. 10-1983(A) Passed 12/14/83 Effective Date 1/1/84]*

#### Article 2. Division Of Public Health.

Sec. 2-201 Prevention and Control; Supervision by Director. The Division of Public Health shall administer that part of the functions of the Corporation concerned primarily with disease prevention and control and shall perform the duties and functions of a local board of health. The Division shall be under the supervision of a Director, who shall be an officer of the Corporation. *[Gen.Ord. 11-1978(A) Passed 7/19/78 Effective Date 7/19/78]*

Sec. 2-202 Administrative Subdivisions. The Division shall have the following administrative subdivisions, which may be altered from time to time as circumstances may require, and which may be supervised by an administrator or deputy administrator:

- (a) Resource Management
- (b) Program Administration.

Sec. 2-203 Subdivisions of Professional Services. The Division shall have the following subdivisions of professional services, which may be administered by bureau chiefs:

- (a) Bureau of Environmental Health
- (b) Bureau of Community Health Services
- (c) Bureau of Disease Prevention/Health Promotion

#### Article 3. Division Of Public Hospitals.

Sec. 2-301 Diagnostic and Curative; Supervision by Director. The Division of Public Hospitals shall administer that part of the functions of the corporation concerned predominantly and primarily with diagnostic and curative work carried on through a hospital, clinic, dispensary or adjunct facility. The Division shall be under the supervision of a Director. The operation of hospitals of the Corporation may be managed under

contract with another firm, institution, or governmental agency, pursuant to Indiana Code 16-12-21-23. [Ed. note: now I.C. 16-22-8-29] [*Gen.Ord. 10-1983(A) Passed 12/14/83 Effective Date 1/1/84*]
